HANDICAPS

- Check your current handicap before each golf competition.
- Australian handicaps are required in all open competitions.
- Only members with Australian handicaps who are full financial members of Narooma Golf Club are eligible to win Board events, Perpetual Trophies, Club Championships, Monthly Medals, Single or 4 Ball K.O. events.
- Members must be fully financial at the commencement of each event.
- It is the player's responsibility to return all cards from other courses for handicapping.
- To be entitled to a handicap a player must be a full financial Member of Narooma Golf Club.
- To obtain an Australian handicap a player shall submit three (3) cards to the Handicap Committee, two (2) of which must be played at Narooma.
- Each card must be verified by a player who holds an official handicap.

FOUR BALL BEST BALL: Stroke Play (including both Par and Stableford). Full Handicap.

FOUR BALL MATCH PLAY: Reduce the handicap of all players by the handicap of the lowest, who will then play off scratch. The other three players are allowed all of the resulting handicaps.

HANDICAP USE

STROKE, PAR and STABLEFORD: Full Handicap.

MATCH PLAY: Difference of Stroke Handicap.

FOURSOMES: Half of Aggregate Stroke Handicap. Players hit off alternate tees and play alternately with one ball.

AMERICAN FOURSOMES: 3/8 of Aggregate Stroke Handicap. Both players play from their tees, exchange balls and play a further shot before playing alternately with the favoured ball.

AMBROSE: Played in teams. All players drive and then select the favoured ball and all hit shots from the vicinity of the favoured ball until holed out. Handicap 2 person 1/4, 3 person 1/6 and 4 person 1/8. Note: Preferred lies through the green for all Ambrose events at Narooma.

CANADIAN FOURSOMES: 3/8 of Aggregate Stroke Handicap. Both players play from their tees, select the favoured ball, play alternately until holed out.

MAJOR CLUB EVENTS

Major and Open events must use AGU Handicap. Honour Board events and Monthly Medals are only open to full financial members of Narooma Golf Club with a current AGU/WGA handicap. Please refer to "Rules and Conditions Covering the Conduct of Tournaments and Events" held by Match Committee.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS: will be played over two consecutive weekends commencing Saturday 29th April and will be stroke play, commencing from the 1st tee.

A Grade - 72 Holes (Sat 29/4, Sun 30/4, Sat 6/5, Sun 7/5).

B Grade - 54 Holes (Sat 29/4, Sun 30/4, Sat 6/5).

C Grade - 54 Holes (Sat 29/4, Sun 30/4, Sat 6/5).

Grades will be determined by GA Handicap and played from the following tees. A - Seahorse, B - Montague, C - Wagonga. The Match Committee may change this event at its discretion. Should wet conditions be such that motorised transport is not allowed, but the course is otherwise playable, championships will be played.

CLUB JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS: to be played over 36 hole stroke play in conjunction with Club Championship Saturday 29th April & Saturday 6th May.

CAPTAIN'S TROPHIES: Individual Stroke Handicap Match Play Knockout for A, B & C Grades. Best 8 qualify in A & B Grade, Best 4 in C Grade. Qualifying rounds Saturday 29th April & Saturday 6th May.

PATRON'S TROPHY: 4BBB Stableford Match Play Knockout. 16 pairs to qualify. Qualifying round, Ray Cooper Event, Saturday 22nd April. Swingers cannot qualify.

PRESIDENT'S TROPHY (TRIATHLON COMPETITION):

One round Stroke, one round Par, one round Stableford. Points system will determine the winner. Must play all rounds to qualify.

STABLEFORD COMPETITION: Five (5) best of seven (7) designated Stableford rounds.

JOHN COBCROFT MEMORIAL: Three (3) best of four (4) designated Stroke rounds.

RAY COOPER: 4BBB Stableford

ANNUAL PAR: Three (3) best of three (3) designated rounds.

LIMON GOLD MEDAL: Best Net score in Stroke round played on Saturday 21st October from season's Monthly Medal winners.

COLIN HOLMES TROPHY: Best aggregate Net score in First and Third rounds of Club Championships - Championship Trophy winners exempt from winning this award.

FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIPS: 18 holes, Saturday 23rd September.

MIXED:

MITCHELL FAMILY MIXED 4BBB - Best 5 of 9 rounds

MONTHLY MEDAL and CRUNCHER CUP

The winner of the Monthly Medal is entitled to use the Cruncher Cup for one month unless he is under-age when the Cup will go to the best senior score. The holder can ask a golfer to fill the Cup on 18 hole golf days once in the month but if he asks a member twice in the month the Cup holder is obliged to shout for the school the member is in at the time.

TIES

In the event of ties, winners of scratch events (Men's Championship) will be decided by a three hole play-off. If it is still a tie, a sudden death play-off will apply from the 4th tee onwards.

Ties in Limon Gold Medal play-off will be decided over 18 holes at a time arranged by match committee. If still a tie, a play-off over three holes as for championships, etc.

All <u>other</u> events will use the uniform count back system for decisions.

Count Back in Ties: Last 9, 6, 3. Then hole by hole from 18th as per Australian Uniform Count Back System.

The Match Committee reserves the right to change competitions as it feels necessary.

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

CANCELLATION OF COMPETITION BOOKINGS:

Players must notify the Professional if, after booking a time, it is not possible to adhere to such a time. Any breach of this will incur a warning with the first offence but will result in a one week suspension for the second offence. All players must realise that other players are missing out on a game because of non-notification of cancellation.

BALLS AND VOUCHERS:

Balls and vouchers won must be collected within three months or they will be forfeited and revert to the Club.

PACE OF PLAY POLICY:

A) Prior to Play

- All players should report to the pro-shop at least 20 minutes before play.
- All players should report to the tee at least 10 minutes before play.
 - B) During Play
- Each group must keep up with the group in front at all times.
- The lowest marker shall be responsible for the pace of the group
- At the end of the round score cards are to be entered in the computer by the player no more than 10 minutes after the end of the round. Cards returned after this time will be deemed as part of the time taken to complete the round.

- The following outlines the breaches for players contravening the pace of play policy:
 - a) Players completing the return of cards within 4 hrs 25 mins of tee time NO PENALTY.
 - b) Players completing the return of cards more than 4 hrs 25 mins of tee time, BUT less than 10 minutes (Stableford and par rounds) and 12 minutes (Stroke rounds) behind the group in front. NO PENALTY.
 - c) Players completing the round in more than 4 hours, 25 mins of time, BUT between 10-18 minutes (Stableford and Par rounds) and 12-20 minutes (Stroke rounds) behind the group in front. 2 STROKE PENALTY.
 - d) Players completing the return of cards more than 4hrs 25 mins of tee time and more than 18 minutes (Stableford and Par rounds) and 20 mins (Stroke rounds) behind the group in front. DISQUALIFICATION

These procedures are for Competition Play on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday. Please note that the Golf shop staff have no discretion with respect to any of the above. Any disputes should be directed to members of the Match Committee. The Match Committee does reserve the right to alter these procedures in the event of any abnormal conditions.

COURSE MARSHALL:

Should the Course Marshall become aware of a group falling behind, the Course Marshall has the authority to issue the group with an official warning. The group will be given 15 minutes from the point of the warning to regain their position in the field, being directly behind the group in front. After this time has passed, if the group has NOT regained their position, they will be issued with a 2 stroke penalty. If the group fails to keep their place in the field a second time the group will be disqualified.

The Couse Marshall also has the authority to request players to pick up their golf balls and proceed immediately to their place in the field behind the group in front. In the case of a Stableford round, players would record a wipe for the holes which have not been played, and in the case of a Stroke round the players will be asked to appear before the Match Committee.

PACE OF PLAY TIPS:

- Shorter hitters play first from the tee or fairway if longer hitters have to wait.
- Do not play honours on the tee, unless in an official Matchplay competition.
- Hit your shot before helping someone to look for a lost ball
 most often they will find their ball while you play your shot.
- Hit your shot when safe to do so, especially if a player farther away faces a challenging shot and is taking time to assess their options.
- If your shot is off line, watch your ball carefully.
- Assess your shot, including putts, while another player is preparing to execute or is executing their shot.
- Hit your shot even if a person who has just played from a greenside bunker is still farthest from the hole but delayed.

- When a player's ball has gone over the back of a green, any player closer to the hole but chipping from the front of the green should play while the other player is having to walk to their ball and assess their shot.
- Leave the flag in place for all players unless they specifically ask for it to be removed.
- Putt, even if you are not the furthest from the hole, if that player is not ready to putt.
- Putt out even if it means standing close to someone else's line.
- Mark your score card <u>AFTER</u> hitting off from the next tee, not while walking off the green.
- Take no more than 40 seconds to play your stroke from when you arrive at your ball and determining it is in play.
- Place your bag, buggy or pull cart between the green and the next tee.
- If falling behind, the first two players who have completed the hole should proceed to the next tee and prepare for/ execute their next tee shot instead of waiting for all players to putt out.
- If the low marker in the group asks, be prepared to speed up play. It is the entire group that may be penalised, not just one player.

Members with guests should make their guests aware of these procedures before teeing off. Should any member or guest feel that they are unable to abide by any of the above, then they should inform the Golf Shop staff immediately.

MAJOR EVENTS – WOMEN

Major events and Monthly Medals are only open to full financial members of Narooma Golf Club with a current GA Handicap.

Please refer to the "Conditions of Play" book, located in the women's locker room, for coverage of all conditions and rules for events conducted at Narooma Golf Club which are controlled and maintained by the Women's Match Committee.

Club Championships: will be played over two consecutive weeks and will be 72 holes of Stroke play.

President's Trophy: Event to be decided by the current Women's President and may change annually.

Captain's Trophy: Event to be decided by the current Women's Captain and may change annually.

Jacket Competition: 3 best Nett Stroke rounds, 3 best Stableford rounds and 3 best Par rounds over the season played in Wednesday Competitions.

Golfer of the Year Division 1 & 2: Points awarded on a sliding scale for Wednesday individual scores during season and aggregated. Divisions decided by Match Committee at the beginning of the golf season.

Gold Medal: Best Nett score in stroke round played on Gold Medal Play-off by those who won the Monthly Medals during the season.

George Family Memorial Nett Trophy: played on designated number of rounds during the season and the average calculated to produce winners and runners up.

HANDICAP ALLOWANCES and COUNTBACKS

Stroke, Par and Stableford: Full Handicap.

Foursomes: 1/2 Combined Handicap.

American and Canadian Foursomes: 3/8 Combined Handicap.

All 4-Balls: Full Handicap.

18 Hole Count back: Last 9 (1/2 handicap) then last 6 (1/3 handicap), then last 3 (1/6 handicap) then hole by hole taking strokes where given.

36 Hole Events: Count back over last 18 holes. If further tie results, proceed as above.

Note: When alternative starting places are permitted, it is recommended that the tie be decided by last 9, 6, 3, 1 holes on card, irrespective of order of play.

Handicap: Each Woman Member must play off the handicap posted by GolfLink Australia.
